Description of a 2.926 Acre Tract (Combining Three Tracts of Record)

Situated in Section 16, T.5, R.13, Waterloo Township, Athens County, Ohio and being all of Parcel "A" and all of Parcel "B" (426-611 O.R.) and all of the 1.23 acre Tract as described in Vol. 426, Page 609 O.R. and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin found with 6" metal plate at the North-west corner of a 1.23 acre tract (426-609 O.R.), said pin bears North 66 degrees 37 minutes 28 seconds East, 950.42 feet from the North-east corner of Fraction 18;

Thence, along the South line of Lemley (93-195 O.R.)

South 80 Degrees 41 Minutes 04 Seconds East a distance of 155.09 feet to an iron pin set; Thence, along the South-line of Green (398-1070 O.R.);

North 67 Degrees 01 Minutes 15 Seconds East a distance of 104.92 feet to an iron pin found; Thence, along the west-lines of Elliott (233-513 O.R.)

South 03 Degrees 29 Minutes 22 Seconds West a distance of 355.36 feet to a point in State Route 691, passing an iron pin found at 327.82 feet that is 0.76 feet right of line; Thence, along State Route 691:

North 86 Degrees 53 Minutes 50 Seconds West a distance of 142.72 feet;

South 74 Degrees 35 Minutes 00 Seconds West a distance of 175.10 feet;

South 71 Degrees 54 Minutes 53 Seconds West a distance of 99.84 feet;

Thence, leaving said road and along the lines of Lemley (93-195 O.R.)

North 12 Degrees 26 Minutes 17 Seconds East a distance of 415.22 feet to a point where an iron pin found with 6" metal plate bears North 81 degrees 12 minutes 18 seconds West, 1.73 feet; North 87 Degrees 56 Minutes 38 Seconds East a distance of 88.83 feet.

which is the point of beginning and containing **2.926** Acres for the combined tracts Parcel "A" N010010056602, Parcel "B"(N010010056601) and the 1.23 acre tract (N010010057000). Subject to all easements and rights of way of record
