


C22612 A.R.E. 7101	Completed Jan. 27, 1927	old east turnout of Th. P.S. at 8275+33.9 and west turnout of Th. 1243AII, P.S. opp. sta. 8273+37.6 removed. A new turnout was installed with a length of 16' between stations 8276+50.5, which lengthens Th. 116, present L. 3812'. A new turnout installed for Th. 1243AII, P.S. opp. sta. 8274+90.7, on Th. 116, 14' long, L. 382'. Distant signal formerly located opp. sta. 8274+59.8 relocated opp. sta. 8274+78. now located opp. sta. 8274+88.8. Distant signal formerly opp. sta. 8274+68.8 is now located opp. sta. 8274+47.7 and one additional signal added to home signal opp. sta. 8274+77.5 Installation of Flashlight Signals 165' to the left and right of stations 8274+71.4 and 8274+89.4. Retirement of Xing Signs and Xing Belts on the left and right of stations 8278+63.0, opp. sta. 8278+78.0, and 8278+86.0.
